



## Call for Candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize (PhD)

**EuPA-YIP.** The European Proteomics Association ([www.eupa.org](http://www.eupa.org)) hereby announces a call for candidates for the EuPA Young Investigator Prize to be awarded at the EuPA Annual Congress from 16-20 June 2018, in Santiago de Compostela, Spain (<http://www.eupa2018.com>). The finalists, selected from the submitted abstracts, will give a short presentation at the closing session of the congress. The winner, judged by the panel after the presentations, will receive €1.000, and a EuPA certificate. The winner of the Young Investigator Prize will also be announced in the major proteomics journals.

**Eligibility.** To qualify, candidates must have started or obtained their PhD or MD degree not later than seven years before the time of submission and must be a member of a EuPA affiliated society and working in a European laboratory. Candidates can either be nominated by senior researchers or by a EuPA affiliated national proteomics society. The national society should have paid their membership fee for 2017 to the European Proteomics Society.

**Submission.** EuPA-YIP candidates should **register, submit an abstract and attend** the EuPA 2018 Congress. Abstracts submission is now open at [www.eupa2018.com](http://www.eupa2018.com). In addition, the abstract and two letters of support of senior scientists should be submitted no later than the **15th of May 2018** to EuPA secretary (Dr. Christian Kleinhammer, [c.kleinhammer@aon.at](mailto:c.kleinhammer@aon.at)). EuPA-YIP finalists will be selected to hold a short presentation and will be notified prior to the conference. Those not selected as YIP finalists will be further treated as normal conference registrants.
